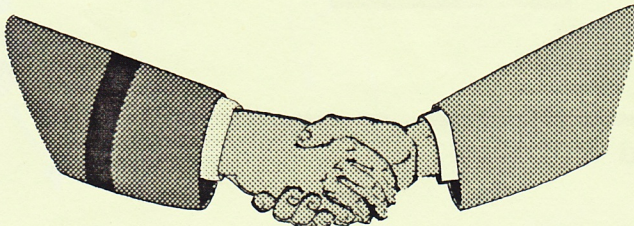
One thing is for sure, your neighbors are interested in making this neighborhood a safe and pleasant place to live. Some of the items discussed were:
