Association Name

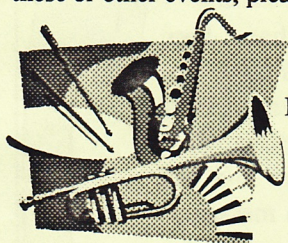

According to Fred Godwin, an original member of our neighborhood, approximately 85% of our neighborhood was originally known as Bel Air. The Womack Co. developed this area from 1947 - 1950. So, that is why BEL AIR has been chosen as the name of our Neighborhood Association. Now that we have a name, all information distributed by the Association will have the name BEL AIR.

In an attempt to develop a schedule of activities for the neighborhood, the steering committee has come up with the following tentative events. If you have any suggestions on these or other events, please let us know.



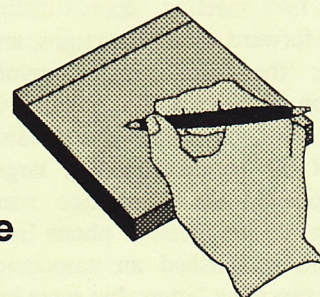

Mark Williams - Facilitator

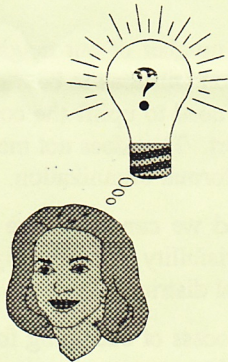
The primary goal of this interim board is to "jump start" the association, prepare bylaws, and organize general elections for the November meeting.

Since our first meeting, approximately twenty individuals have come forward, taken the reigns, and formed a committee to address the initial issues involved in starting an organization of this type. The Steering Committee, as they are formally known, have chosen our name, organized the first meeting of the neighborhood at large, elected an interim board, registered the association name with the City of Phoenix, set up the message phone line, registered for a Tax ID Number, established an association checking account, distributed two news letters; but most importantly, have begun to address the concerns voiced by our neighbors. The meetings are open to anyone in the neighborhood. If you would like to attend we ask you hold your comments until the meeting agenda has been accomplished. 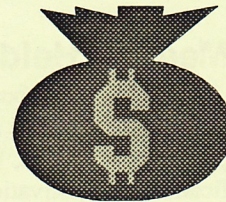

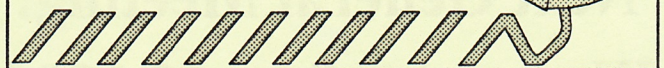
Neighborhood Hotline
