We also have big pan lasagna that will feed 6 hearty appetites and cost about \$3.33 a person. Our Big Dinner Me Lasagna is a big pan lasagna plus salad for 6 and 12 garlic bread sticks and costs about \$4.99 per person. We believe these are good solutions for entertaining and feeding guests at a decent price. Pick it up here - bake it in your home. We don't sign our name on our products, so if you wish to, you can claim you baked it yourself, which would be true.

Tuesday morning, October 14, 1997, we were featured on Fox 10's Good Morning Arizona. Rick Dimico baked our Lasagna on the show in 6 minutes. His comments were, "I'm Italian and this food is fantastic."

You can use the landfill for free...

You can dispose of small residential refuse loads at no cost on weekends and one residential load a month on weekdays.

They must be less than 10,000 pounds and contain no liquid waste or household hazardous waste. Also, a maximum of five car or truck tires are allowed per resident per year.

The landfills are located at 31st Ave. and Happy Valley road and 27th Ave. and Lower buckeye Rd.
